1. Read I Corinthians 14:26-28. What was happening in the Corinthian church when the people gathered for worship? What was the purpose of these unique expressions of the Spirit through the Corinthians? How were they to regulate the gift of tongues?
2. Read I Corinthians 14:29-33. What regulations are placed on the expression of the gift of prophecy? How much control do “prophets” have when it comes to expressing the gift of prophecy? How does this control reflect God’s nature?
3. Read I Corinthians 14:39-40. How would you describe the tension that is addressed in these verses? Why do think God allows so much human influence on His work through these gifts of the Holy Spirit?

1. Do you regularly attend worship at church? Why? What do you hope to receive? What do you hope to give?
2. Before you attend a worship gathering, do you pray that you can be used by God to care for others?
3. As you sit among the crowd on a Sunday morning, do you pray that God will speak to you? Do you pray that God will speak through you?
4. When it comes to the idea of God speaking through you, which barrier is the biggest?

 - c. I’m concerned I may be stepping outside of Scriptural boundaries.
