

BIBLE QUESTIONS

Read Titus Chapter 3

Paul gives Titus some specific instructions in chapter three. What are they? (3:1, 3:8-10, 3:13, 3:15)

At times, Christians are criticized for being judgmental and condescending. In contrast, verse two says we should “show true humility toward all men.” What should be the source of our humility and what would true humility look like (verse 4-5)?

In verses 4-6, what provides us with salvation and what doesn't? Explain some of the specific things that happen that provide salvation to a person who places their trust in Jesus.

In verse 8, what is it that Titus is supposed to emphasize? Why? Compare this with Titus 2:11-14; how is this passage related?

In verse 13, what are the “good things” Paul may have intended for Titus to do?

According to verse 14, what is the goal of doing what is good? What do you think might have been going on in Crete to cause him to say this? How might this apply to us today?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Take a few minutes to share your story of God's rescue in your life. What would your life be like right now if you didn't know Jesus? How does remembering this better enable believers to fulfill the directives of Titus 3:1-2.

If you don't know Jesus, how do you think your life might be different after knowing Him personally?

Read 3:8. What are the good things that you are devoted to? If Jesus was not in your life, would you still be devoted to them?

What are some of the “good things” you wish that you would do, but just haven't moved forward with them? What will be required of you to do these good things? Do you believe God is calling you to do this? Have you been putting this off? If so, why?
