

## **BIBLE QUESTIONS**

Read 1 Corinthians 1:19-21. In what ways has the Gospel been confused with “foolishness?”

Read 2 Corinthians 3:18. What does “ever increasing glory” mean? Using the Michelangelo analogy, where is God “chipping” away in your own life?

Read Romans 8:28: What is God’s promise to those who love Him?

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

Where in your faith do you simply need to trust the Lord even when you don’t have all the answers?

How has your perception of Jesus progressed over the years?

What is it about a simple testimony that we often have so much trouble with?

Are there people in your life you have deemed “unworkable?” How might God actually be working in their lives? Are there areas in your own life you have deemed “unworkable?”

What does your cardboard say?: “I once was \_\_\_\_\_ but now I \_\_\_\_\_.”  
If you are in the midst of pain now, it may be hard to complete that sentence.  
Are you willing to claim the promise of Romans 8:28 and allow your CARE group to pray for you?

According to Ephesians 2:8-10...it is by grace we are saved and transformed, therefore, we shouldn’t take His credit. Where in your life do find yourself taking the credit for God’s work in your life?
