Share an example of a time in your life when you were asking God for direction. How did He answer? What was the result?

Specifically, how have you seen the Body of Christ (the Church) be the "hands and feet" of Christ? How do you think these people knew what God wanted them to do?

Do you have a sense of where your life is heading? If so, how committed are you to listening to the Lord's voice, regarding this direction?
